What is the Registry?

- The Office maintains a confidential registry of all individuals with disabilities and their needs. This is used as an advocacy tool to expand the availability of services and supports in the community and to improve services already in place.
- The registry can be used to identify people who may need special assistance during an evacuation for a disaster. We collaborate with Emergency Management in this area.

Who is eligible for services?

- The Office for People with Disabilities works with anyone with a disability as is defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act. This includes anyone from birth to senior citizen, and his or her caregiver. The Office is a County agency and therefore receives no fee for rendering its assistance.

What is the Resource Guide?

- The Office has developed the **Putnam County Information, Resources and Referral Guide for Individuals with Disabilities and Their Families**. This guide is available FREE of charge and can be obtained by contacting our office.

What does the Office do?

In addition to the registry & the Resource Guide, other activities of our office are:

- Supporting and promoting community awareness relative to the American with Disabilities Act and any other relevant legislative acts.
- Assisting in identifying the needs of people with disabilities, and address those needs with referrals to direct services.
- Cooperating with government and not-for-profit agencies that plan and implement programs for people with disabilities.
- Supporting volunteer programs in the community that provide services to people with disabilities.
- Publishing a quarterly newsletter with important information including a community calendar with upcoming events for various disabilities.
