**PUTNAM COUNTY HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAY**  
**SCHEDULED FOR SATURDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2011**

Putnam County will hold a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day for Putnam County residents on Saturday, October 8th, 2011. The Putnam County Department of Health and New York State Department of Environmental Conservation are co-sponsoring the FREE Household Hazardous Waste Collection event which is scheduled from **9:00 am to 12:00 pm (rain or shine) at the Putnam County Department of Health, 1 Geneva Road, Brewster, NY.**

Improper storage or disposal of hazardous waste poses a health risk to residents and their families. Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day is an opportunity for Putnam County residents to safely dispose of toxic materials such as: household cleaners, pesticides, herbicides, oil based paint (not latex), automotive solvents, thinners, mothballs, rodent poisons, gasoline, kerosene, small propane tanks (up to 20 pound size), etc. Disposal items will only be accepted if they are labeled and identifiable. Items which will **not** be accepted are water-based paints (latex), used oil, batteries, plastic bags, tires, electronic waste or any materials from commercial establishments.
