


## A Powerful Veterans Program





#### To Whom It May Concern,

In September we will be bringing the Traveling Vietnam Wall to Putnam County Veterans Memorial Park for the fifth time. In conjunction with the Wall, we will also have the American Traveling Tribute that honors all the wars America has been part of since the Revolution. We will also be hosting a half-sized replica of the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. This event is a collaboration between the Putnam County Veterans Service Agency and the Putnam County Joint Veterans Council (PCJVC). The PCJVC is a local non-profit Veterans Service Organization.

We believe that this is an excellent educational and community service opportunity. Being fully cognizant that this is early in the school year and that the school does take students to the Wall during the Washington trip there are benefits to the students and teachers that are unique to the Traveling Wall being in Putnam. The fact that it is nearby is an obvious advantage. However, the golden opportunity is that there will be Vietnam Veterans on site to interact with the students and teachers. There is little chance in DC for the students or faculty to interact with Veterans. Further most of the Vietnam Veterans in attendance will be local Veterans. These could be people the students see every day. It is a rare occasion to actual be with the heroes of our nation. It is our hope that you can present the students at your school with this gift.

Thanks in advance for any consideration you may be able to give. Please feel free to contact us to arrange a visit. The Wall will be open from Noon on September 22-25, 24 hours per day until 3:00 PM on September 25.
