- Volunteer service performed for people, organizations or the community must have been *unpaid*.
- Only individual volunteers are eligible for this award; volunteer groups will <u>not</u> be considered.
- The nominator may be one of the volunteer's 3 mandatory references, unless the nominator is a parent or relative of the nominee.
