The County continued the following programs: Household Hazardous Waste Collection, E-Waste Collection, Prescription Drug Take Back, Tree Program, and PARC Litter Patrol. The County also added a rain barrel workshop as well as increased advertisement of these programs.

**B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.**

The County saw an increase in participation of the following programs: Household Hazardous Waste Collection (2 events with 409 participants), Prescription Drug take back (3 events, 507 participants, 1,540 lbs. collected), Tree Program and PARC Litter Patrol program (55,431 lbs. collected). E-Waste collection decreased slightly due to a period when collection ceased while finding a new contractor that did not charge for CRTs.

During this reporting period, the County made the following observations: (1) 226 repair permits were issued by the County for 226 septic systems, (2) 3479 Putnam County Data and Inspection Forms were submitted by septage haulers, and (3) 100 illicit discharges were reported, of which 30 were confirmed and 30 were eliminated. The County Septic System Data and Inspection Forms were also used to notify the County of septic failures.
