

## SIGN MAINTENANCE WORKER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is semi-skilled work involving responsibility for the efficient and workmanlike performance of a variety of sign construction, painting and related tasks. General instructions are received regarding the tasks to be performed permitting some leeway for planning the details of each assignment. Supervision may be exercised over the work of laborers. Performs related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Prepares metal and wooden blanks for the application of sign facings;  
Applies preprinted faces on signs;  
Prepares surfaces by cutting, scraping, sanding, washing and applying paint and varnish remover;  
Drives posts for signs and mounts signs on posts;  
Paints stop bars, railroad crossing warnings and similar traffic controls and warnings on pavement;  
Cleans and maintains painting equipment and supplies;  
Compiles running inventory of paints and other materials used;  
Maintains simple records regarding placement of signs;  
Operates or assists in the operation of snow and ice control equipment;  
May supervise laborers and helpers;  
Performs a variety of related activities as required.

*Typical Work Activities are intended only as illustrations of possible types of work that might be appropriately assigned to an incumbent of this title. Work activities that do not appear above are not excluded as appropriate work assignments, as long as they can be reasonably understood to be within the logical limits of the job.*

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology and accident precautions of the trade; skill in the layout and painting of signs; ability to follow written and oral instructions; good color perceptions; good motor, hand and eye coordination; manual dexterity.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

One (1) year of experience in the layout, painting and construction of signs.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:

Access to transportation may be required to complete possible field work assignments in a timely and efficient manner.
