Dear NYS Retailers of e-cigarettes or e-liquids:

On September 12, 2019, the Public Health and Health Planning Council approved amendments to regulations in New York State (Part 9 of the New York State Sanitary Code) that require signage warning against the dangers of illegal e-cigarette and e-liquid products. These emergency regulations were adopted to protect public health in response to the increasing number of people that have suffered injury or died from severe respiratory illness associated with vaping.

Effective September 12, 2019, any business that offers e-cigarettes or e-liquids for sale, must post the attached NYS Department of Health published sign in a conspicuous place. By requiring the posting of this sign, the NYS Department of Health expects that consumers will become more educated about the risks associated with vaping.

Currently, there is a nationwide outbreak of severe lung disease associated with vaping, and the NYS Department of Health is engaged in an educational campaign to warn people against the potential risks associated with these products.
