DASHBOARD DEFINITIONS

Confirmed Cases	A cumulative count of all laboratory-confirmed positive cases reported to the Putnam County Department of Health. (Putnam County Residents ONLY)
Released	A cumulative count of all laboratory-confirmed positive cases that meet New York State Department of Health criteria for release from Home Isolation/Quarantine.
Active Cases	A cumulative count of all laboratory-confirmed positive cases that do not meet New York State Department of Health criteria for release from Home Isolation/Quarantine.
Hospitalized	A daily count of laboratory-confirmed positive (COVID-19) patients currently hospitalized at Putnam Hospital as reported by Putnam Hospital.
Deaths (County Residents)	Fatalities of Putnam County Residents caused by or related to COVID-19 as reported by the New York State Department of Health.
Tests Administered	A cumulative count of the number of tests administered as reported by the New York State Department of Health.
COVID-19 Related 211 Calls	All calls to the Putnam County 211 Line related to COVID-19 as reported by 211 staff. Date range is specified.
COVID-19 Related 911 Calls	All incoming 911 calls (to the Putnam County Bureau of Emergency Services, Emergency Communication Center) related to or reporting COVID-19 symptoms/diagnosis/etc.
